- Regulation







Buckley Close - Block A, 4 kWp - 16 x Sunmodule Plus SW 250 poly



## **SOLARISE Pilots: PV+GSHP**







Elwyn Jones Court – housing for seniors Replacing out-of-date electric panel heating Expected saving: ~£45 (on solar PV only – heat pump savings much larger)



# Group purchase of solar panels – Solar Together

- Cheaper installation of solar panels for able-to-pay households – home owners
- Councils trusted agents write to home owners to invite registration to the scheme
- Auction run Autumn 2020, selection of installer
- Price reduction based on likely number of installations
- Marketing campaign, customer information sessions Nov-Dec 2020
- Installation phase to June 2021
- Worked with agents iChoosr
- Managed by West Sussex County Council

## Solar Together – headline achievements



European Regional Development Fund

- 9 out of 11 Sussex councils participated in the scheme
- 116,603 suitable Sussex households identified and targeted with Direct Mail
- 6127 households registered
  - 5.25% registration rate against iChoosr's 3.5% target
- 1050 offer acceptances across all 11 council areas
  - (exceeding iChoosr's 15% target)



• 12% of acceptances have led to installations with 3 months to go.

# Solar Together learning points

- 1. Efficiency
  - Meeting deadlines, internal communication, internal decision processes
- 2. Data
  - Gathering, analysis & quality checks on direct mail data
- 3. Local installers
  - Ensuring local installers have the opportunity to bid for the work
- 4. Marketing
  - Working collaboratively, planning, sharing material
  - Higher level of marketing leads to increased take-up
